An Overview:

The E-learning *Short Course In Literacy and Language Skills (SCILLS)* program is a stand-alone course designed to progressively teach the literacy concepts and skills individuals need to know and acquire to be proficient at Reading, Speaking, Writing, Listening and Viewing. Developed using Flash technology, *SCILLS* is user-friendly and imparts the 4S method of learning and teaching in an interesting and enjoyable way.

SCILLS is presented in 25 Modules and can be mastered in a thirty-hour plus or minus, time frame depending one's skill level. Students are able to progress at their own learning pace enabling those who need to review, revise and reinforce what is being taught to do so in their own time schedule. *SCILLS* can also be facilitated in a classroom in conjunction with the computer program.

This interactive course lays a conceptual and skills foundation on which one can continue to build throughout one's educational journey and apply in all other educational pursuits where English is a prerequisite, for example, preparing for the *International English Language Testing System – IELTS* tests.

Based on the 4S accelerated, learning methodology, it can be introduced at virtually any age and skill level and is ideal for the literacy-impaired, those for whom English is their second language as well as for the average and excellent student.
